Seine River First Nation is requesting applications for Members to fill two (2) Initial Member Trustee positions for the Seine River First Nation Legacy Trust.

What is the Seine River First Nation Legacy Trust? A soon-to-be-formed Trust that will hold and administer Seine River First Nation's Flooding Claim and other claim settlement funds for the long-term benefit of the First Nation and its Members.

Member Trustee Duties include:

- 1. Adhering to and carrying out the terms of the Trust Agreement;
- 2. Attending and preparing for Trust and Community meetings;
- 3. Setting annual budgets;
- 4. Reporting on Trust activities to Council and Community Members;
- 5. Overseeing the management and investment of the Trust funds;
- 6. Establishing and reviewing Trust policies and procedures;
- 7. Completing Trustee training; and
- 8. Reviewing and selecting Trust advisors.

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. Must be a Member of SRFN and be 18 years or older;
- 2. Must be a resident of Canada for purposes of the Income Tax Act;
- 3. Must not be a member of Chief and Council;
- 4. Must not be an undischarged bankrupt;
- 5. Must be of good character;
- 6. Must provide a satisfactory Criminal Record Verification; and
- 7. Must not be declared mentally incompetent by a court or by a capacity assessment.

Additional Information: One (1) Member Trustee must be normally resident on-reserve and one (1) must be normally resident off-reserve. The term for the Initial Member Trustees will be one (1) year. Thereafter, Member Trustees will be appointed for staggered four (4) year terms.

Initial Member Trustee applications will be reviewed to ensure the applicants have the qualifications outlined in the Trust Agreement. Recommendations for appointments will be presented to Council for approval.
